And Surrender! Luke 21:37; John 8:1

Message: November 15, 2020

Key thought: People can do what God wants them to do.

Parent Helps:

- Invite your child to tell about a time when he was first. He/she might tell about winning a game, being first in line, and so on. Ask: "How did it feel to be first?"
- Comment that God wants people to surrender to Him. Explain that to surrender to God means that God has first place. His commands are more important than anything! A person who surrenders to God chooses to do the things that God wants.
- · Explain that Jesus surrendered to God. Jesus did the things that God wanted Him to do, even when it was hard.
- · Read Luke 22:39-42.

Discussion Questions:

Younger Kids Questions:

- 1. What is something that God wants people to do?
- 2. When is a time that you obeyed God even though it was hard?
- 3. Why should people do the things that God wants them to do?

Additional Older Kids Questions:

- 1. When is a time that it might be hard to surrender to God?
- 2. Why is it important for people to surrender to God?
- 3. How can people know what God wants them to do?

Apply:

- · Choose to do the things that God wants you to do. (Proverbs 3:5-6; Romans 12:2; James 4:7,10)
- Trust God, even when it's hard. (Psalm 9:10; Psalm 37:5; Jeremiah 29:11; 2 Corinthians 5:7)

Activity:

Invite your child to draw a picture of a time when he/she did what God wanted him/her to do. Turn the paper over. Lead your child to draw a picture of a time when he/she finds it difficult to obey God. Remind your child that he/she can do the things that God wants him/her to do, even when it is hard. Talk together about a strategy to help him/her obey during difficult times.

Pray Together:

- · Thank God for the Bible and His plans.
- · Ask God to help your family surrender to His plans, even when it's hard.
- Praise God for our new Preschool/Children's space! Pray for your kid's staff as they prepare for our first day in the new building this Sunday!
