#### Matthew 5:9 "Peacemakers"

Addressing a large crowd overlooking the sea of Galilee, Jesus reminds us that peacemakers in His Kingdom will be recognized as partaking of God's nature. After all, God is the "God of Peace" (Hebrews 13:20) and Jesus is the "Prince of Peace" (Isaiah 9:6). What does the Bible, and specifically this passage tell us about peace? Notice that...
