## Hello Whitesburg family,

As you are aware, recently the President released a road map for helping states begin the process of reopening and recovering from the physical and economical effects of COVID-19. The process will happen in three phases. Phase One plans for Alabama have been released and will tentatively begin May 1.

As we have studied the plan for reopening and recovery, it has become clear that social gatherings for larger crowds will not occur until the later phases. Based on the information we have at this time, it will be difficult to effectively implement Whitesburg's summer activities. After prayerful consideration, the pastoral staff has determined that it is in the best interest of the church to focus our primary energy in helping our church connect in worship, Life Groups, and ministry to those in need. We will forgo summer activities for 2020. This includes VBS, student camp, high school mission trip, weekday in-person Bible studies, Upward flag football – all summer activities.

Whitesburg will resume ministry in two phases. Phase I begins today and will be known as "Re-Engage." Our focus is on preparing a safe, successful, and meaningful return of the church body once the restrictions for social gatherings are lifted. The pastoral staff is putting in place the proper safety protocols that will enable us to do this effectively. This includes proper greeting practices, cleaning, disinfecting all areas of the campus, and ensuring social distancing measures are in place. As we receive more information, we will make determinations about gathering sizes and times. We will also monitor and encourage those who fall into high-risk categories to continue to shelter in place and take advantage of our continuing online opportunities.

Phase II is our Fall Launch 2020. In this exciting phase, we will move into our newly renovated Worship Center at the Main Campus. On May 3, Pastor Darryl is going to provide a detailed overview of the renovation project during the 9:30 am online worship service. His report will include live video and a timeline for completion.

For now, we will continue our online presence for worship and Life Groups until we can physically reunite.

We love you! We miss gathering with you. We are here for you. Call us if we can be of help or service to you in any way. We continue to pray that God will overwhelm you with His peace, power, and presence as we continue to trust Him during these uncertain days. God bless you!
