#### A Return to Worship Gathering Plan

At Whitesburg Baptist Church, we exist to help people encounter Jesus and experience life change. This happens best in relationship with one another and, most importantly, as we live in relationship with God. For this unprecedented time, we've had to make adjustments in how we gather as a church family. We still are abiding by guidelines established by the CDC and government officials. However, our plan at this time is to begin limited corporate worship with no other gatherings or activities on June 7, 2020. The following guidelines will be necessary to allow us to gather safely.

\* Please note that these dates and plans are tentative and subject to change as we receive additional guidelines.\*

Everyone should feel comfortable with the decision they make for their family (single, couple, or with children), whether to gather in-person or continue to shelter in place. We will continue our online streaming presence for those who choose not to attend in person at this time. We look forward to the day we all can be together safely, knowing there is no replacement for the physical family gathering of the church.

Hebrews 10:24-25 "And let us consider how to stir up one another to love and good works, not neglecting to meet together, as is the habit of some, but encouraging one another, and all the more as you see the Day drawing near."

#### Important Notes:

- If you are not feeling well (have a fever, are coughing, or experiencing shortness of breath) please stay home and participate online.
- As exciting as it will be to see each other again, please do not engage in greetings that require any touching (hugs, handshaking, high fives, etc.)

#### Facilities:

- We will follow strict guidelines to sanitize the building prior to Sunday mornings and between service times.
- We will have a new traffic flow both in the building and parking lot to reduce contact and maximize the number of people we can safely allow in worship.
- We will make our building as "touchless" as possible by ...
  - Propping doors open and stationing greeters at least six feet away from doorways.
  - There will not be a printed bulletin.
  - There will not be Bibles, pens, contact cards, etc. in the seats. (We will use a texting service to register and get to know our quests.)

#### Registration and Pre-Service Preparation:

- Services: Service times will be determined as we get closer to June 7.
- Participation Limits: Because we are meeting in the Fellowship Dining Room and will continue practicing social distancing, the capacity for each service will be greatly reduced. Under current directives, we anticipate that we will be limiting each service to 300 attendees. Reservations can be made for each service on our website or by calling the church office at 256-881-0952 once the system is activated.
- Masks: Wearing a mask will not be mandated for the services but will be left to each person's comfort level.
- Parking: Please park only in front (east side) of the South Campus and arrive no earlier than 15 minutes prior to the service time. This will give time for the previous service to clear the parking lot and allow time for proper sanitizing of the facility.

#### Worship:

- Opening: The Fellowship Dining Room will be open 15 minutes before the service. Please do not congregate in the lobby and hallways prior to this.
- Flow: Everyone is asked to enter the building only through the front doors of the South Campus and the Fellowship Dining Room through the doors marked "Entrance." To Exit, use the "Exit" doors to the right (as you are approaching the back of the room) of the sound booth and continue across the hall to the Chapel and out the doors on either side to the parking lot. Please allow the people in the rear of the room to exit first and work its way to the front of the room to maintain appropriate distancing.
- Seating: Enter the row on the right (as marked) and move across until there are two seats between you and the next family. Please do not sit on the end, requiring others to cross in front of you. Every other row will be closed to maintain proper distancing front to back.
- Music: There will be no choir or orchestra due to social distancing. Services will be lead by either Rick Stone and a praise team or Jon Muccitelli and the band
- Preaching: The same sermon will be presented at each service by our pastor (or substitute should he have to be away).
- Children and Students: We will not be providing on-campus activities for any age group at this time. Families are requested to sit together. No childcare will be available for these services.
- Offering: We will have offering boxes in the lobby and at each entrance and exit to the Fellowship Dining Room. Plates will not be passed and please do not hand your offering to an usher or staff member.
- Lord's Supper: We will use sealed, self-contained Lord Supper kits on the days we take the Lord's Supper and distribute without having to pass plates.
