Re-Engage

AT WHITESBURG BAPTIST CHURCH

Church family, we are remaining with our plan of returning to in-person worship on **June 7, 2020**. Your church staff wants you to know that we have missed you and are committed to doing everything we can to make sure we are ready for your return. Below are the measures we will be taking to ensure a safe and meaningful return.

- We will offer **3 identical services each Sunday** at 8, 9:30, and 11 am and will add additional services as they become necessary.
- We are requesting that you **pre-register weekly** for the service you plan to attend. This will help us to best manage our services and be sure there is a spot for everyone. The smaller capacity of the Fellowship Dining Room coupled with the social distancing requirements limit us to only 300 worshippers in each service.
 - Register online at WhitesburgBaptist.org/WorshipRegistration. (Registration will open approximately 2 weeks prior to the first service.)
 - If you need assistance, call the church office and the receptionist will gladly help you.
 - Reserve a seat for each family member that will be attending. **At this time, there will be no nursery or preschool care for children.**
- Masks are optional. Please understand that people have very differing opinions on wearing masks. Your decision on when to return to worship should be based on your comfort level of being around others who may not share your same views.
- When you arrive at the South Campus:
 - Please enter through the front doors only
 - Avoid congregating in the lobbies and hallways, please adhere to strict safe distancing protocols.
 - Ushers will be available to help you find a seat
 - Families must sit together.
 - Do not sit on rows that are marked off.
 - Enter on the right side of the row and move down until there are 4 seats between you and the next family.
- As you leave:
 - Exit to your left through the designated doors.
 - Allow the back rows to exit first and move towards the front of the room.
 - Exit either across the hall through the Chapel or through the south doors leading to the Prayer Garden.
- Sunday Life Groups will not be meeting on campus at this time.
- We are making efforts to be as touchless as possible.
 - All doors will remain propped open.
 - Please avoid greetings that involve touching (i.e. handshakes, hugs, or high fives).
 - Tithes and offerings will be collected in boxes at the entrances and exits.
 - Lord Supper elements will be distributed (when observed) in self-contained kits as you enter rather than passing plates.
 - Printed bulletins, pew Bibles, contact cards, or pens will not be available.

We care about your well being and that of all in attendance. If you are not feeling well (fever, coughing, or shortness of breath) please do not attend. Join us for online worship at home.

Worshiping in-person will look different as we return, but let us rejoice in the opportunity to do so and say with the Psalmist, "I was glad when they said to me, 'Let us go to the house of the Lord.'" Psalm 122:1

You are feeling sick, have a fever, are coughing,

General Guidelines:

- Please adhere to strict social distancing, 6 feet apart

- Face masks are recommended

Areas Open:

- Walking Track (no running or passing): Limit 8 persons
- Weight Room: Limit 5 persons
- Cardio and Alcove Areas: Limit 6 persons
- Please wipe down exposed surfaces before and after using each piece of equipment

Restrictions:

- No fitness classes
- No sports activity in gym (i.e. basketball, etc.)
- Indoor playground closed/no birthday parties
- Showers are not available
- No food consumed on the premises, bring your own drinks (fountains and vending not available.)
- The south side of the building and the atrium are closed
