God Is Great!

Level of Biblical Learning: God is real, the only true God.

1 Samuel 17

Parent Helps:

- Invite your child to describe each family member (physical characteristics, likes/dislikes, and so on).
- · Ask: "What is God like?"
- Read aloud Psalm 86:8-10.
- Emphasize that no one is like God! God is the Creator; He made everything! God is wonderful, awesome, and powerful. He is perfectly good and loves people. God can do anything, and He deserves our praise!
- Explain that God knows everything about us. He always knows what is best, and we can trust Him.

Discussion Questions:

Younger Kids:

- 1. What is something that only God can do?
- 2. How does God help you when you have a problem?
- 3. God is great! What is something you can do to tell God how great He is?

Older Kids:

- 1. Has anyone ever broken a promise to you or let you down? How did it make you feel?
- 2. How is God different from people?
- 3. How do you know that you can trust God?

Apply:

- Remember that God is great! (Genesis 1:1; Numbers 23:19; Job 26:36; Isaiah 40:28; 1 Chronicles 16:25)
- Trust that God can do anything! (Genesis 18:14; Psalm 147: 5; Mark 10:27; Luke 1:37)
- Worship and praise God! (Psalm 29:3; 95:6; 150; Colossians 3:16; Revelation 4:11)

Activity:

Grab some sidewalk chalk and head outside. Help your child make a chalk drawing that praises God. Include words of praise, favorite Bible verses, drawings of favorite Bible stories, and so on. Talk about God and His greatness as you create.

Pray Together:

- Praise God for who He is.
- Thank God for the ways He cares for your family.
- · Ask God to strengthen your family's faith and help you trust Him.
