

The Principle of Obligation - Luke 10:25-37 Message: August 16, 2020

DISCUSS:

This Sunday Pastor Darryl began the *GO!* sermon series in our time of worship. This week the focus is on *The Principle of Obligation*.

Key thought: Jesus wants us love, serve, and care for others.

Read (or tell the story) and discuss the story of the Good Samaritan with your children found in Luke 10:25-37. Consider using a children's story Bible such as the Jesus Storybook Bible.

QUESTIONS:

- Ask your kids to think about some ways they can love their neighbors
- Ask your kids if they have any ideas of how they can serve their neighbors

THINGS TO DO:

- Register on <u>www.blesseveryhome.com</u>
- Decide on a time each day that you will begin praying for your neighbors with your kids (i.e. meal times, before bed, etc.) and explain why this is important
- Gather your family at the table, draw a tic-tac-toe grid, write your family's name in the center, and see if you can fill in the houses all around you in the remaining squares
- Brainstorm ways you can get to know your neighbors:
 - Make cookies and take to neighbors
 - Older kids can offer to sweep driveways, sidewalks, etc.
 - Younger kids could make a craft to take to an older neighbor who may live alone
