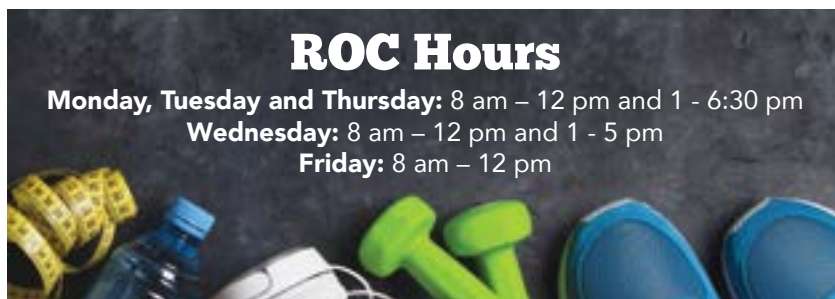


Preschool & Children's Life Group/Worship Registration

Church family:

Thank you for your continued generosity during these unprecedented times. Your gifts, tithes, and offerings make it possible for us to continue the work of spreading the gospel to Huntsville and around the world.

Because of your faithful giving and prayer support, Whitesburg Baptist Church enters a new fiscal year with a strong vision for the future. We will close out the current 2019-20 year with an estimated **\$7.7M** in general contributions. This is nearly 11% ahead of last year's giving and represents a historic level for Whitesburg.

While our financial history and future is strong, your Lead Team recognizes that these are unpredictable days. The 2020-21 Ministry Plan is intentionally proposed as relatively flat, with a modest \$36K change from the current year. The proposed **\$7.2M** Ministry Plan allocates more funds directly to ministry, including Discipleship, Missions, and Worship, all while funding building renovations (worship center and children/preschool).

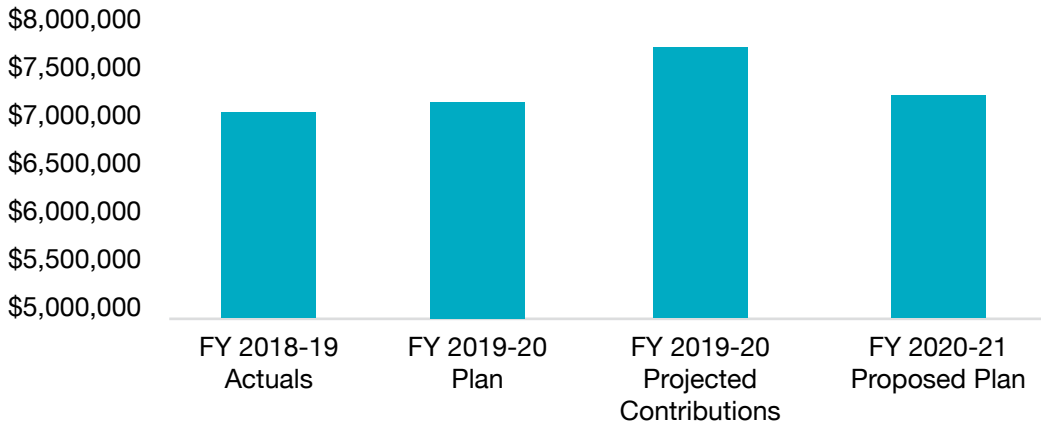
