

The Principle of Mission - Luke 10:37

Message: September 13, 2020

Key thought: Jesus commands us to live our life on mission to declare the gospel and demonstrate the love of God.

PARENT HELPS:

- Ask your kids if they remember the story of the Good Samaritan. If not, reread or retell the story of the Good Samaritan with your kids found in Luke 10:30-37.
- We get excited when we talk about things we enjoy or things we like to do. What are some things that you enjoy doing? What are some things about Jesus that makes you excited to talk about Him?

QUESTIONS:

- What does it mean to be an ambassador for Christ? See 2 Corinthians 5:16-21.
- Where has God called you to be an ambassador for Him?
- God's call for us to "Go" is an intentional action. What does it mean to be intentional? How can we be more intentional in loving others?
- What are some ways that you can demonstrate mercy, compassion, and kindness like Jesus this week?

APPLY:

• Explain to your kids that because Jesus loves us, we are commanded to love our neighbors and share the gospel.
