Message: September 20, 2020

- Acts 26 -

DISCUSS:

- Do you have a “Jesus story?” Take some time to walk through it, either with your family or in your journal, using the following prompts from the message:
 - a. My Life Before Jesus
 - Who were you before Jesus? How was your life different?
 - b. How I Came to Christ
 - Who shared? Where did it happen? When did it happen?
 - c. My New Life in Christ
 - How are you different now that you are a new creation? Is there evidence of Jesus in your life? What is that evidence?

APPLY:

- If you do have a story, are you prepared to clearly communicate the Gospel? What is your preferred method for doing so? Does it cover the essential parts of the Gospel, as well as set the stage for those receiving it to understand their newfound purpose in life?
- If “I don’t have a story” describes you, what questions do you have? Ask someone you know who is a follower of Jesus to have a conversation with you today!
- What do you need to do to grow in your understanding of the Gospel? Make a list of action steps you can take to more closely follow Jesus! But remember, “by grace we are saved through faith.” Moralism, including checking off lists and doing good deeds, is not the Gospel. Only Jesus does the saving!
- Go and share your story!!! Be bold (Romans 1:16). You can do it with the help of the Lord!
