

What is Your Story? Message: September 20, 2020

Key thought: It is important that we know the Gospel and can share with others how we came to know Christ.

- 1 Corinthians 15:1-4 -

PARENT HELPS:

- Share your own personal story with your children of how you came to know Christ.
- Parent Tip: Where were you? When was it? Who was involved?
- Ask your children if they can share their gospel experience with you.
- Parent Tip: You may know your child's gospel experience or even been a part of that experience. It's important that our children are able to voice their own personal gospel experience and practice sharing it with people who are close so that they may one day share it with others. If your child does not have his/her own gospel experience to share, this is a wonderful opportunity to have open conversation regarding a decision to know and follow Christ.

QUESTIONS:

- What does it mean to "know" Christ? See I Corinthians 15:1-4
- What does it mean to be "born again"?
- Who do you know that needs to hear your gospel experience so that they too may know Christ and have their own gospel experience?

APPLY:

• The gospel message is that we are all separated from God because of our sin. The result of our sin is emptiness and an ever-present guilt and fear of death. But God loved us in spite of our rebellion and He sent His own Son to die in our place and forever bridge the gap between God and us.

ACTIVITY:
